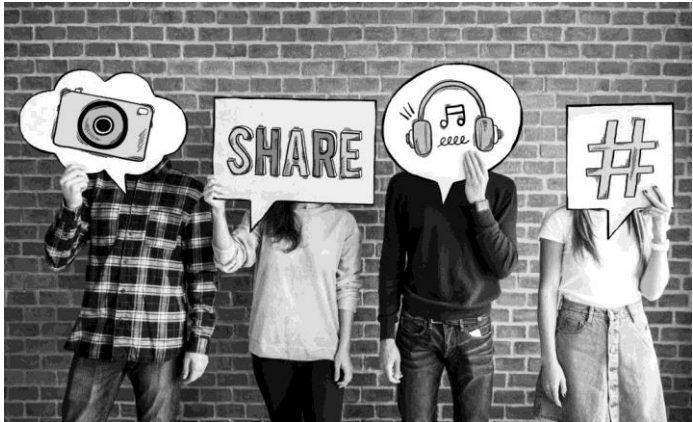

Bergvliet High's solar power project has produced 60% of our energy consumption in its first year saving 26 tons of coal, prevented 64 tons of CO₂ going into atmosphere and is the equivalent of planting 3500 trees. We have reduced our electricity costs and we sell electricity back to the grid.

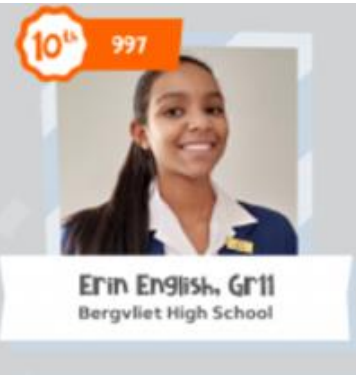
I'd like to take a moment to acknowledge the hard work, unique identity, and skills of the learners of BHS who competed this year. We are proud of them!

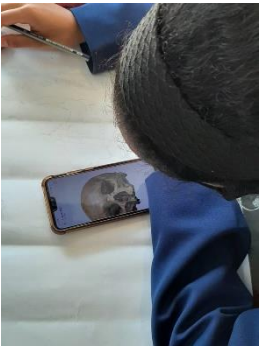

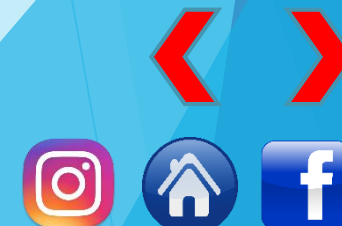
