

Thousands of students who write the first round, have to qualify for the second round, and only the top 100 students, Grade 10 -12, then write the final round. Top 100 in the country and neighbouring countries. Absolutely excellent. But his achievements did not stop there. He wrote the UCT Mathematics competition, qualified to compete in the second round, known as the UCT Mathematics Olympiad, and was then invited to participate in the final round known as the UCT Mathematics Challenge.

We are so proud of you Uzair and congratulate you on these achievements. We wish you all the best for the future and know that we will still hear much about you.














## **GUN RUN**

Kudos to Jordan Ohlson for championing this initiative! I'm incredibly proud of our learners for spreading love and kindness beyond the boundaries of BHS.


