MATRIC VISUAL ART EXHIBITION 2022

Another FIRST for Bergvliet High is happening in October and we want you all to Save the Date. We are thrilled to announce that, for the first time ever, the Matric Art Expo will be held at the Blue Route Mall from 18 October until 23 October. We are inviting the whole school community to visit the exhibition between 9am and 7pm daily. This is an incredible opportunity for our young aspiring artists to showcase their work to a much wider audience than usual.

Let me explain why we are doing this. Over the years our Music, Dance and Drama departments have been able to showcase their talents at world renowned venues such as the Baxter, Artscape, the Waterfront Amphitheatre and Grand West Grand Arena. Imagine performing in front of 5000 people at the Grade Arena!! Not only did our Music department do this but they also walked away with the Top Prize of R30 000.

Our Visual Art Department, however, has been restricted to the campus. The Matric Art Expo is on display at school for about 36 hours at best and many people do not get the opportunity to see the incredible art our learners produce. Our Visual Art department is renowned for producing excellent artists. One of our past learners is Derric van Rensburg, who is internationally known for his superb impressionist paintings and is widely rated as one of South Africa's top artists.

Over coffee one day Mrs Shukla and I decided we needed to take our Matric Art Expo off campus to afford our learners the exposure to a much broader community. The idea has grown and in collaboration with the Blue Route Mall, we now have the opportunity to provide this exposure. We want you to spread the word far and wide, and not only that we want you to go and see our exhibition. In addition to the Matric Art we will also be showcasing some of our grade 10's and 11's work. The reason for this is to provide them with the experience so that they can step up their game for future years. Having one's work showcased to the wider public will bring a greater expectation in the quality of work needed to be world class. Some of our learners are already getting national exposure for their work, so this is not a pipe dream.




The Library was a busy place during the National Book Week.

WOMAN UP DONATE SANITARY PRODUCTS


